Dave,

You should put 16 ounces (473 ml) of AmerSeal in your 160 X 60 X 18 rear tire and 11 ounces (325 ml) of AmerSeal in the 120 X 70 X 17 front tire. After installing AmerSeal you should take your motorcycle for a drive. Start out slowly for a mile or so until the AmerSeal has time to coat the inside of the tire. After the first mile go another mile or two at normal speeds. That all you need to do. If you ever need to remove the AmerSeal from your tires it can be rinsed out of the tire and off the wheel with water.
