Mr. Haley:

In Kansas we took a 14 ply tire that was mounted to a utility trailer and filled it with Amerseal. We then shot a 7.62 mm through it 14 times in the side wall of the tire and 4 times in the tread area. We then drove around. If we stayed below 30 MPH it held air, but anything over that and the size of hole was too large to hold in the Amerseal do to centrifugal force. The test was conducted by request of the Cherokee Indian Nations distributing who does U.S. government contracts. The test was performed using U.S. DoD standards for tire sealant in war zones and passed. Results of the test were turned over to the U.S. DoD and TACOM (U.S. Tank-automotive and Armaments Command) for review. As a result of this test Amerseal is now approved for use in U.S. government vehicles.
